Several organizations involved with the Take Action on Radon Campaign will be present for interviews. Protecting children from the long-term risk of lung cancer is a priority.

The goal of the national Take Action on Radon Campaign is to engage Canadians to test for Radon and fix their homes, daycares, schools and places of work if the level of Radon is high.
